FOREMAN

The Foreman reports to the site supervisor and provides leadership and direction specifically to the field project team. The Foreman coordinates between the subcontractors and the General Contractor's labor force, coordinating installation and routing of project components. Physical requirements of the job include lifting 25 pounds on a regular basis and occasionally up to 80 pounds in a safe manner, utilizing team lifting when possible.
